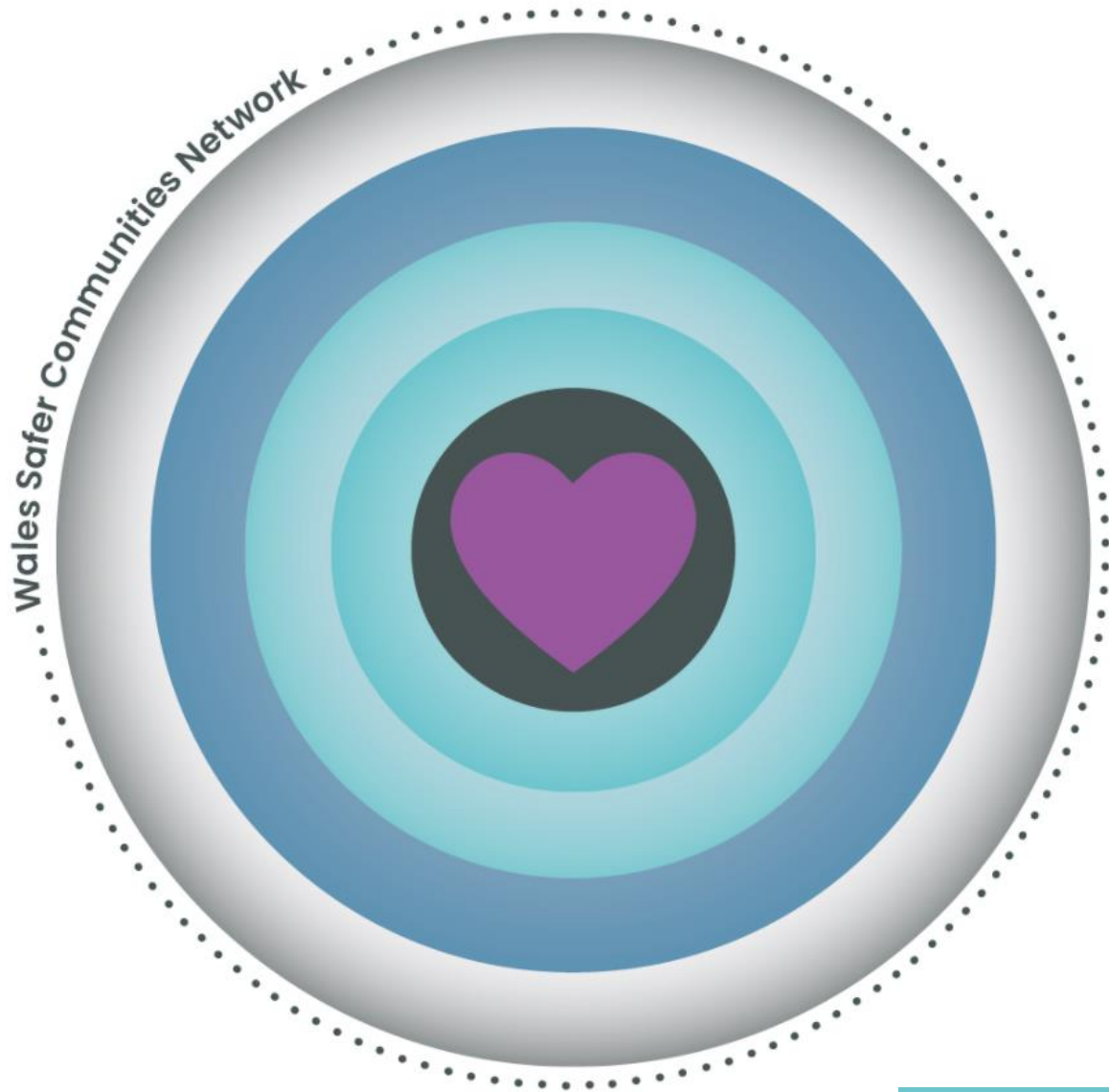

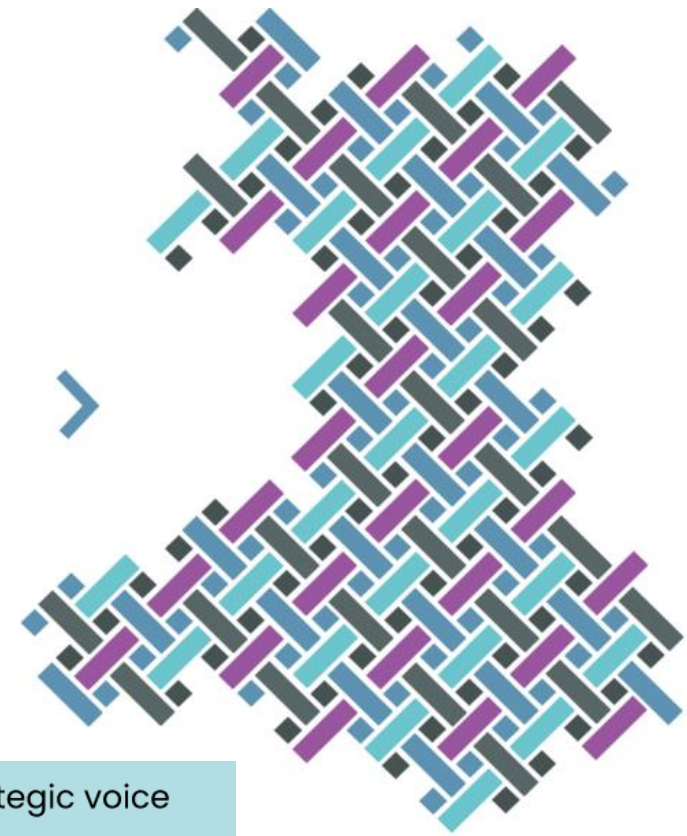

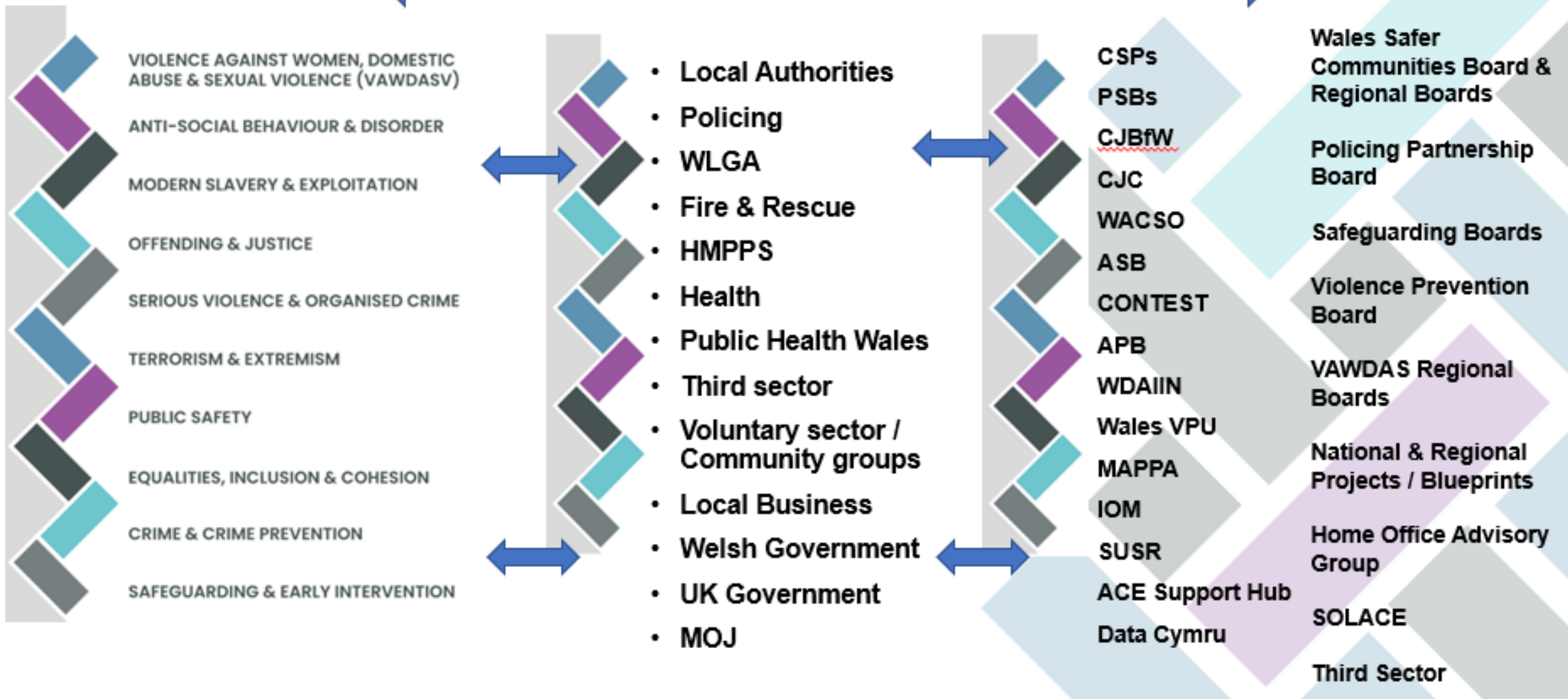
OUR MISSION
